1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a  
 3 legislative rule relating to the application for waiver of initial licensure fees for certain  
 4 individuals.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on June 14, 2023, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, modified by the West Virginia Board of Barbers and  
 3 Cosmetologists to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and  
 4 refiled in the State Register on August 24, 2023, relating to the West Virginia Board of Barbers and  
 5 Cosmetologists (application for waiver of initial licensure fees for certain individuals, [3 CSR 15](#)), is  
 6 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the application for waiver of initial licensure fees for certain individuals.
