1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Licensed Dietitians to promulgate a legislative rule  
3 relating to telehealth practice, requirements, and definitions.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Licensed Dietitians.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2023, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-35-4 of this code, relating to the West Virginia Board of Licensed Dietitians  
3 (telehealth practice, requirements, and definitions, [31 CSR 07](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Board of Licensed Dietitians to promulgate a legislative rule relating to telehealth practice, requirements, and definitions.
