1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule
 3 relating to requirements for registration and licensure and conduct constituting
 4 professional misconduct.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Registered Nurses.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2023, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-7-4 of this code, modified by the West Virginia Board of Registered Nurses to
 3 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State
 4 Register on November 16, 2023, relating to the West Virginia Board of Registered Nurses
 5 (requirements for registration and licensure and conduct constituting professional misconduct, [19](#)
 6 [CSR 03](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to requirements for registration and licensure and conduct constituting professional misconduct.
