1 A BILL to amend and reenact §49-2-121 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to rule-making by the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Resources; and
 3 requiring a rule for child subsidies to be based on monthly enrollment rather than daily
 4 attendance.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. STATE RESPONSIBILITIES FOR CHILDREN.

§49-2-121. Rule-making.

1 (a) The secretary shall promulgate legislative rules in accordance with §29A-3-1 *et seq.* of
 2 this code regarding the licensure, approval, certification, and registration of child care facilities and
 3 the implementation of this article.

4 (b) The secretary shall review the rules promulgated pursuant to this article at least once
 5 every five years, making revisions when necessary or convenient.

6 (c) The rules shall incorporate, by reference, the requirements of the Integrated Pest
 7 Management Program established by legislative rule by the Department of Agriculture under
 8 §19-16A-4 of this code.

9 (d) The rules shall provide that child subsidies shall be based on monthly enrollment rather
 10 than daily attendance.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require child subsidies shall be based on monthly enrollment rather than daily attendance.
