1 A BILL to repeal §55-9-1, §55-9-2, and §55-9-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
2 all relating to repealing antiquated provisions relating to void gaming contracts, recovery
3 and loss of money in gaming, and recovery of gaming losses by bill in equity.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§1. Repeal of article relating to gaming contracts.

1 That §55-9-1, §55-9-2, and §55-9-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, are
2 repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal §55-9-1, §55-9-2, and §55-9-3 of the Code of West Virginia to remove antiquated provisions of the code relating to gaming activities.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
