1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
 2 designated §18B-22-1, relating to requiring West Virginia public institutions of higher
 3 learning to classify children of graduates from any West Virginia public college or university
 4 as an in-state student.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE	22.	IN-STATE	STATUS	EXCEPTION.
§18B-22-1.	In-state	resident	status	for tuition purposes.

1 Children of graduates from any West Virginia public institution of higher education shall be
 2 classified as West Virginia residents for the purposes of tuition, room, and board at all West
 3 Virginia public universities and colleges.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require children of out of state alumni of all WV state universities and colleges to be classified as in-state students.
