1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2 designated §47-6-1a, relating to the fact that the State of West Virginia solely recognizes
3 United States coins and currency as legal tender for all transactions, public and private.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 6. MONEY AND INTEREST

§47-6-1a. Recognizing United States currency as legal tender for transactions.

1 The State of West Virginia to shall recognize United States coins and currency as legal
2 tender for all transactions, public and private.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is for West Virginia to recognize United States currency and coins as legal tender for all transactions.
