21 combined number of students in the Hope Scholarship Program and students eligible who have
22 applied to participate in the Hope Scholarship program during the previous school year is less than
23 five percent of net public school enrollment adjusted for state aid purposes for the previous school
24 year, then, effective July 1, 2026, a child is considered to meet the requirements of this paragraph
25 if he or she is enrolled, eligible to be enrolled, or required to be enrolled in a kindergarten program
26 or public elementary or secondary school program in this state at the time of application;

27 ~~(6)~~ "Hope scholarship funds" means the moneys deposited in a Hope Scholarship
28 student's account in accordance with the requirements of this article.

29 ~~(7)~~ "Hope scholarship student" means a student who receives a scholarship pursuant to
30 this article;

31 ~~(8)~~ "Parent" means a biological parent, legal guardian, custodian, or other person with
32 legal authority to act on behalf of an eligible recipient or Hope Scholarship student;

33 ~~(9)~~ "Participating school" means any private school located in West Virginia that provides
34 education to elementary and/or secondary students and has notified the board of its intention to
35 participate in the program and comply with the program's requirements;

36 ~~(10)~~ "Resident school district" means the county school district in which the student
37 resides; and

38 ~~(11)~~ "Treasurer" means the West Virginia State Treasurer.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prevent the use of state funds to pay costs for attending out-of-state private schools or receiving other services from an out-of-state provider.
