1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
3 centralized prescription processing.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Pharmacy.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2023, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-5-7 of this code, modified by the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy to meet the  
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 September 26, 2023, relating to the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy ( Board of Pharmacy rules  
5 for centralized prescription processing, [15 CSR 14](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to centralized prescription processing.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
