1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative
 3 rule relating to reporting requirements for independent contractors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-10-1. Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2023, authorized under the
 2 authority of §22A-1-6 of this code, relating to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training
 3 (reporting requirements for independent contractors, [56 CSR 10](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to reporting requirements for independent contractors.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
