1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative
 3 rule relating to assessing health and safety violation penalties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-10-1. Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2023, authorized under the
 2 authority of §22-1-4 of this code, modified by the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to
 3 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State
 4 Register on September 15, 2023, relating to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training
 5 (assessing health and safety violation penalties, [56 CSR 12](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to governing assessing health and safety violation penalties.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
