1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative  
3 rule relating to the application process for the West Virginia Innovative Mine Safety  
4 Technology Tax Credit Act.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-10-1. Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2023, authorized under the  
2 authority of §11-13BB-13 of this code, modified by the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and  
3 Training to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in  
4 the State Register on September 15, 2023, relating to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and  
5 Training (rule pertaining to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training application process  
6 for the West Virginia Innovative Mine Safety Technology Tax Credit Act, [56 CSR 14](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the application process for the West Virginia Innovative Mine Safety Technology Tax Credit Act.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
