### **Senate Bill 134**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative  
 3 rule relating to substance abuse screening, standards, and procedures.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-10-1. Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2023, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §22A-1A-2 of this code, modified by the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training  
 3 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State  
 4 Register on September 15, 2023, relating to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training  
 5 (substance abuse screening, standards and procedures, [56 CSR 19](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to substance abuse screening, standards and procedures.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
