## Senate Bill 438

BY SENATORS WOODRUM AND DEEDS

[Introduced January 12, 2024; referred

to the Committee on Government Organization]

A BILL to amend and reenact §5-30-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
to requirements for rosters of individuals who have obtained professional, occupational,
and trade licenses, registrations, and certificates made available to public; establishing
exception for certain authorizing entities; and removing geographical information from
rosters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### ARTICLE 30. ROSTERS OF INDIVIDUALS AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE PROFESSIONS, OCCUPATIONS, AND TRADES.

# §5-30-2. Roster of licensed, registered, or certified practitioners to be made available to the public; <u>exception.</u>

1 The secretary or director of every board, commission, agency, or entity that issues 2 licenses, registrations, or certificates, or otherwise authorizes individuals to practice a profession, 3 occupation, or trade in this state, except for those subject to the provisions of §30-1-13 of this 4 code, shall prepare and maintain a complete roster of the names and mailing addresses of all 5 persons licensed, registered, certified, or otherwise authorized to practice in this state the 6 profession, occupation, or trade to which such board, commission, agency, or entity relates, 7 arranged alphabetically by name. and also by the municipalities or counties in which their mailing 8 addresses are situated Each such board, commission, agency, or entity shall make the roster 9 available upon request to any member of the public and shall also place and maintain the roster 10 on its website if it maintains one.
