1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 2 designated §5A-4-7, relating to the replacement of the statue of the Honorable Robert C.
 3 Byrd with a statue of George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, James Madison, and Arthur I.
 4 Boreman, one each, placed in a corner of the rotunda of the Capitol.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 4. GENERAL SERVICES DIVISION.

**§5A-4-7. Replacement of statue of Robert C. Byrd with statues of George Washington,
 Abraham Lincoln, James Madison, and Arthur I. Boreman.**

1 (a) The Legislature directs the secretary of the Department of Administration to plan and
 2 replace the statue of Robert C. Byrd with a statue of George Washington, Abraham Lincoln,
 3 James Madison, and Arthur I. Boreman, one each, placed in a corner of the rotunda of the Capitol.

4 (b) The General Services Division of the Department of Administration shall use funds from
 5 the special "capitol renovation and improvement fund" previously created for funding of the
 6 replacement of the Robert C. Byrd statue and creation and placement of the statues of George
 7 Washington, Abraham Lincoln, James Madison, and Arthur I. Boreman.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to replace the statue of the Robert C. Byrd with a statue of George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, James Madison, and Arthur I. Boreman, placed in each corner of the rotunda of the Capitol.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
