A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended by adding thereto a new section,
designated §18B-4-11, relating to creating an associate's or bachelor's degree based on
skills, education, and experience earned while serving in the military.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
