1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
 3 injectable pharmaceutical agents certificate.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Optometry.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 31, 2023, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §30-8-6 of this code, modified by the West Virginia Board of Optometry to meet the  
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
 4 November 16, 2023, relating to the West Virginia Board of Optometry (injectable pharmaceutical  
 5 agents certificate, [14 CSR 11](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Board of Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating to injectable pharmaceutical agents certificate.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
