Re: Enrolled Senate Bill 683

Secretary Warner:

Pursuant to Section Fourteen, Article VII of the Constitution of the State of West Virginia, I hereby disapprove and return Enrolled Senate Bill 683. This bill purports to exempt hydrogen from the motor fuel tax. This bill, while well-intentioned, fell technically short of accomplishing its intended purpose. Specifically, the bill failed to exempt hydrogen from the motor fuel tax when used as a motor fuel since hydrogen would remain taxable under the definition of a special fuel.

I encourage the Legislature to revisit this issue and to meet with representatives from the Tax Department to ensure a bill to exempt Hydrogen from the motor fuel tax amends all necessary sections of West Virginia Code to accomplish the purpose.

Accordingly, I hereby disapprove and return Enrolled Senate Bill 683.
