1 A BILL to amend and reenact §17E-1-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to commercial driver's license; and requiring that a state employee with a commercial
3 driver's license have a current medical evaluation certification and may not have a medical
4 waiver.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 1. COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE.

§17E-1-18. Rule-making authority.

1 The commissioner shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to carry out the provisions
2 of this article: *Provided*, That the commissioner shall propose rules for legislative approval in
3 accordance with §29A-3-1 *et seq.* that require a state employee with a commercial driver's license
4 to have a current medical evaluation certification and that the state employee is not entitled to a
5 medical waiver from this requirement.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require that a state employee with a commercial driver's license have a current medical evaluation certification and may not have a medical waiver.
