A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §61-7-18, related to requiring the safe storage of firearms.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## ARTICLE 7. DANGEROUS WEAPONS.
