- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,  
2 designated §17-4-56, relating to requiring the Commissioner of Highways to include  
3 rumble strips on double-yellow lined highways when upgrading.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE                    4.                    STATE                    ROAD                    SYSTEM.**

**§17-4-56. Rumble strips required on double-yellow lined roads.**

- 1        The commissioner shall require the placement of rumble strips on all double-yellow lined  
2 highways when upgrading, beginning July 1, 2025.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require rumble strips on double-yellow lined highways when upgrading the highway .

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
