## Senate Bill 551

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §61-2-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 increasing the penalty for second degree murder.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### ARTICLE 2. CRIMES AGAINST THE PERSON.

#### §61-2-3. Penalty for murder of second degree.

- 1 Murder of the second degree shall be punished punishable by a definite term of
- 2 imprisonment in the penitentiary which is of not less than ten nor more than forty years 15 years to
- 3 <u>life imprisonment.</u> A person imprisoned pursuant to the provisions of this section is not eligible for
- 4 parole prior to having served a minimum of ten <u>15</u> years of his or her sentence or the minimum
- 5 period required by the provisions of §62-12-13 of this Code code, whichever is greater.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the penalty for second degree murder.
