Gentlemen:

During the June interim meeting, the Joint Committee on Government Operations made several requests of PERD for information regarding the Preliminary Performance Review of the **Contractor Licensing Board**. We are providing the following information in response:

1. *How often did the Contractor Licensing Board meet and was there a quorum present at its meetings as required by the code?*

PERD determined that the Board met 11 times in FY '92, 9 times in FY '93, 5 times in FY '94, 10 times in FY '95, and 8 times in FY '96. There was a quorum for all meetings held except one; the Board is only required by code to meet once a year. (See Attachment A for more detailed analysis.)

2. *Was the General contractor license intended to be an umbrella license and what are the differences among the various types of licenses (general, HVAC, etc.)?*

Material provided by the Board indicates that the General contractors license was not intended to be an umbrella license. The definitions provided clearly define the requirements of a General contractors license and the restrictions of the license. Meeting minutes demonstrate that discussions were held before the Board concerning this issue. There was some confusion about the intent of the General Contractors

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classification and some contractors apparently took the test thinking that they would be able to do residential work and commercial work. The Board took this problem into consideration and voted to grant both licenses to these persons. (Attachment B contains a short explanation of the intent of a General Contractors License, copies of Board Meeting minutes discussing changes to rules regarding General Contractors licensure and a page of definitions of the various classifications of Contractors licenses)

3. *How long does it take for a person to become licensed?*

A license can be issued within two or three days if an individual passes the required examination. A lot depends on the individual and how proactive they are. Contractors must be registered with other agencies such as Workers Compensation, the Tax Department and the Secretary of State's Office before they can be issued a license. (Attachment C provides a short explanation of the length of time it takes to obtain a license. Also attached are computer printouts demonstrating when an applicant applied and when an actual license was issued)

4. *Is the 60-day grace period to become licensed given to violators of the law excessive?*

The issue of the Contractor Licensing Board rescinding Cease and Desist (C&D) orders issued to unlicensed contractors if they become licensed is mandated by title 28 of the Legislative Rules. The rules do not specifically state; however, the C&D must be removed if the person is licensed within 60 days, but that, "The order shall be withdrawn upon issuance of a license to such person". In addition, the rules provide that the Board may impose a penalty of not less than \$200 nor more than \$1000 upon a person engaging in a contracting business in this state without a valid license. Nothing specifically mandates that fines are removed if a person is licensed within sixty days. However, the rules do state that a person adversely affected by any action of the Board may appeal to the Board within sixty days and that the Board shall hear the appeal within sixty days of receipt of notice of appeal. It appears that the Board's decision of rescinding fines if the person is licensed within sixty days is of its own discretion and within its power.

5. *How much revenue is generated by the program annually versus how much revenue needs to be expended to run the program?*

Table one Below details the receipts and expenditures of the Board since its inception.



6. *A poll of the Contractor Licensing Board members on their views of the Division of Labor's use of the Contractor Licensing funds was requested?*

The Performance Evaluation and Research Division conducted a survey of the current Board members. Of the current members only seven responded. Of these members five believe that Contractors Licensing fees are being used to subsidize the General Revenue fund. Two members were unsure or did not know if this was the situation. Some members commented that the financial information they are provided is not very detailed.

We hope this information is responsive to the inquiries made by the committee at its last interim meeting.

ATTACHMENT B

GENERAL BUILDING CONTRACTOR LICENSE

It seems to be rather clear that a general license was not the intent when the Contractor Licensing Act was drafted. The Act specifically defines the general building classification and residential classification. Note on page 14 of the Rules under the general building definition which states in part: "A general building contractor is considered to be a commercial, business or industrial contractor."

WV CONTRACTOR LICENSING BOARD
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FEBRUARY 21, 1995

Jon Scearcy, d/b/a Best Homes Company (WV008741), 930 6th Avenue, Huntington, West Virginia, for abandonment of a construction project without legal excuse which he contracted in writing to complete, failed to furnish the materials and labor he contracted and return money given to him to buy materials. Mr. Jon Scearcy did not appear on his behalf. A motion was made by Mr. Ferguson to suspend Mr. Scearcy's license until the judgment is paid. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

GENERAL BUILDING CLASSIFICATION NOTIFICATION

The board opened the discussion up to the public and four (4) general building contractors spoke out against the requirement to hold two (2) classifications if you do both commercial and residential work. Commissioner Leary addressed all of the correspondence and telephone calls the Division of Labor had received regarding the notification that was sent out to all general contractors who hold only a general building classification but also do residential contracting. The Commissioner suggested all contractors who hold the General Building classification should be allowed to continue doing residential work under that classification. If a contractor holds only the Residential Building classification they would have to test to upgrade their present license to perform commercial work. Mr. White made a motion that anyone who holds a General Building Contractor's License is qualified to do both commercial and residential work. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

UPDATE ON CONTI CONSTRUCTION, INC.

Updating the Board of the status of Conti Construction, Inc. To date we have not received any further information from them. Issue tabled until further information is provided.

REQUEST TO QUALIFY MORE THAN ONE COMPANY WITH SAME TEST SCORES

A request from Mr. William J. Kuthy to transfer his test scores for his business and law and general building examination to qualify Johann Corporation, d/b/a American Developer. Mr. Ferguson made a motion to reject Mr. Kuthy's request. Motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

K. C. Logwood and HPI, Services, Inc. requesting to qualify more than one corporation with the same test scores.

Mr. Ferguson made a motion to reconsider the Mr. Kuthy's request and these issues be tabled until the board can develop some guidelines. Motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

HEARING EXAMINER'S RECOMMENDATION FOR PERSONNEL TEMPORARY SERVICES

A request was presented to the Board to adopt the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law regarding the administrative hearing conducted on December 24, 1994 appealing the \$1,000 monetary penalty assess to Personnel Temporary Services, Inc. Mr. Carl made a motion to accept the hearing examiner's recommendation. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

HEARING EXAMINER'S RECOMMENDATION FOR PAUL BOSTIC

A request was presented to the Board to adopt the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law regarding the administrative hearing conducted on January 6, 1995 appealing the \$1,000 monetary penalty issued to Paul Bostic. Mr. Bell made a motion to accept the hearing examiner's recommendation. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

CHEMICAL PROTECTION & SPRINKLER INSTALLER

A request for information pertaining to Chemical Protection and Sprinkler Installer examinations. Mr. Ferguson made a motion to separate Chemical Protection and Sprinkler Installer into two categories as per the scope we have presented to us. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

AIR & WATER BALANCE EXAMINATION

A request for a subcommittee to review questions for Air & Water Balance examinations with National Assessment Institute. The Board suggested that the Division of Labor come up with some names of people who would qualify to help make up test questions and categories, if they have any names of people who would be interested in being a part of the subcommittee they will refer them to Mr. Chris Quasebarth.

REQUEST FROM BOB GREENLEAF

The Board considered a request from Bob Greenleaf to reconsider his \$500.00 monetary penalty issued in 1992. Mr. Bell made a motion to suspend Mr. Greenleaf's license until he pays the fine. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

REQUEST FROM THE DIVISION OF LABOR

A request by the Division of Labor to reconsider the fine issued to Westfall Construction because incomplete information was presented to the Board. Mr. White made a motion to rescind Westfall

Constructions fine. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

REPORT FROM COMMISSIONER LEARY

Ms. Leary wanted to inform the board that we have nine (9) new compliance officers and that a more extensive report will be given at the next board meeting. Also a meeting of the board is scheduled for March 17, 1995 at the Division of Labor's office.

Contractors holding the General Building classification can do residential and commercial building but they cannot do HVAC, Plumbing and Electrical in commercial projects.

The Contractor Licensing Board will be reviewing the list of untested specialties and informing DOL staff which specialties require testing under other classifications.

Chairman Strock called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

Approval of March 21, 1995 meeting minutes.

Mr. Carl moved the minutes of March 21, 1995 be accepted as presented and unanimously carried.

Public Comment

There were no comments from the public.

DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

The Board conducted a hearing under disciplinary provisions of the West Virginia Contractor Licensing Act (§ 21-11-14), requested by Mr. James P. Martin, counsel for Ricardo Salinas, Fidel San Juan, Santiago Mora, Angel Olozagaste and Julio Cesar Conpean, 525-527

Winchester Avenue, P. O. Box 1898, Martinsburg, West Virginia . Mr. Martin testified that a \$17,944.25 judgment was obtained in Berkeley County Circuit Court against Victor W. Dill (WV013668), 158 Flowers Lane, Winchester, West Virginia, for deliberate failure to pay any moneys when due for any services rendered in connection with such person's operations as a contractor. Mr. Victor W. Dill did not appear on his behalf. A motion was made by Mr. Cannon to suspend Mr. Dill's license until the judgment is paid. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

The Board conducted a hearing under disciplinary provisions of the West Virginia Contractor Licensing Act (§ 21-11-14), requested by Mr. Ronald L. Brammer, d/b/a Arrow Coal Grove, Inc., 300 Marion Pike, Coal Grove, Ohio. Mr. Brammer testified that a \$15,000.00 judgment was obtained in Lawrence County, Ohio Court of Common Pleas against Mr. Larry Z. Medcalf, d/b/a Medcalf Construction Arrow Coal Grove, Inc. (WV023044), 1117 E. 4th Street, South Point, Ohio, for deliberate failure to pay any moneys when due for any services rendered in connection with such person's operations as a contractor. Mr. Larry Z. Medcalf appeared on his behalf and testified on his behalf. A motion was made by Mr. Carl to table the issue until further information is provided. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

HEARING EXAMINER'S RECOMMENDATION MIRAGE DECORATING

A request was presented to the Board to adopt the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law regarding the administrative hearing conducted on March 13, 1995 appealing the \$500.00 monetary penalty assessed to Mirage Decorating. Mr. Cannon made a motion to accept the hearing examiner's recommendation. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

SUGGESTED RULE CHANGES

Mr. Quasebarth presented suggested changes to the rules, as previously discussed. Brief synopsis of changes made in Series 1, § 3.3, the definition of administrative hearing cleaned up the language, changed to rules "of the board", because there is also information in Series 2 relating to administrative hearings. § 4.2, the Board shall commence all meetings at 11:00, changed to "9:00", because the Board always meets at 9:00. § 6.4 and 6.5 talking about notice of meetings emergency and regular meetings, to be sent to Secretary of States office for publishing in the State's register that is required and will remain, "notice shall be made similarly to the news media" has been taken out. If the Board chooses to publish it to the media it can still be done. § 8.2 the Board shall select a Chair and added in a Vice-Chair and the election will take place at the annual meeting. § 8.3 added in a

line "in the absence of the Chair the Vice-Chair shall execute all duties of the Chair". § 9.1 reads that each member will be reimbursed for all actual expenses, I added in "in accordance with law", this is not going to change anything you will still be reimbursed for your actual expenses, but in case the Statute changes and there is a restriction on it, there is no conflict on it with the rule. § 12.1.4 under administrative hearings, the assistance of an attorney duly qualified to practice law in the State of West Virginia, added in "at the person's own expense", so there is no question as to who is paying for that attorney. § 12.2 testimony in reference to administrative hearing, added "the Board shall maintain the complete record of the proceeding of the administrative hearing", the Board shall prepare an official record which shall include the transcript of the testimony and all exhibits admitted into evidence, added "upon the request of a party to the proceeding or upon its appeal", the way the rule read prior to these changes the Board was required to make a transcript of every administrative hearing, with these changes the Board can just keep the record, keep the tape and if a transcript is requested, or if someone appeals, a transcript can be made. § 12.5 continuances of administrative hearings, added "its appointed hearing examiner", so it reads the Board or its appointed hearing examiner shall rule upon motions of continuance.

Series 2, effective dates and filing dates have been marked through. § 3.14 definition of general building contractor, changed the language to reflect the Board's determination on a general building contractor being able to do both commercial and residential work, and clarified that a residential contractor engaged in commercial contracting must also have those specific classifications. Mr. Cannon objected to this rule change. Mr. Carl made a motion to revisit the motion that was made at the February 21, 1995 regarding General Building Contractors. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried. Mr. Cannon made a motion to work with the original language of the definition for a general building contractor. § 3.20 Multi-family contractor definition added "residential" and struck the last line "as defined by this rule". § 3.26 Asphalt contractors, strike "residential" and just list asphalt contractor. § 3.27 Residential Concrete strike "residential" and just list Concrete contractor. Added definitions in 3.37, 3.38, 3.39, and 3.40 for the four tested specialty classifications. § 5.3 add the current license fee of \$90.00. Mr. Strock asked why not strike the reference, if it has to be re-written each time we may raise the fee? Mr. Quasebarth responded that he believed that without the fee specified in the rule, the Board may not legally have a fee. § 5.5 Renewals, added "renewal will occur upon verification that licensee is in compliance with WV Code 21-11-5(c). Mr. Ferguson stated that conditional licenses were voted out and will be marked out. § 6.2

added tested classification that the Board has added as specialties and added "and such other specialty classifications as it the Board may determine warrant examination". § 9.1 reads: "any person adversely affected by any action of the Board may appeal to the Board within 60 days of such action, added "other than an action taken by the Board as a result of an administrative hearing conducted by the Board", so if the Board conducts an administrative hearing there is not the requirement in the rule, that the Board has to conduct another administrative hearing on appeal.

A motion was made by Mr. Cannon to strike the changes made in Series 2, § 3.14 general building contractor definition, and to keep the definition as it was originally written. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

Mr. Ferguson stated that early in the rule process the Board decided to eliminate § 5.6 reference to a conditional license.

The Board directed Mr. Quasebarth to enter the Rule changes as presented with the changes the were requested by the Board, and upon consultation with Mr. Jividen as to the fee issue and technical aspects.

CITATIONS

Informed the Board of a new citation form that was developed to be issued to contractors who do not list their contractor license number on cards or advertising or post it at job sites. The Board can fine up to \$200.00 when a contractor is found in violation. Contractors who subcontract to unlicensed contractors should be taken to court. The Board directed Mr. Jividen to take all Contractors who hired unlicensed subcontractors to court, starting from this meeting.

SEARS AMERICAN SIDING & DECK, INC.

A request by the Deputy Commissioner to rescind the fine issued to Sears American Siding & Deck, Inc., because they were licensed under the name of American Siding & Deck, Inc.. Mr. Cannon made a motion to rescind Sears American Siding & Deck, Inc. fine. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

SPECIALTY LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS

Tabled until next meeting.

REQUEST DIRECTION FROM THE BOARD REGARDING FINES

Commissioner Leary request direction from the Board concerning fines that were issued to Godfrey's Trucking, d/b/a Custom

Buildings, Action Builders, Tracy Gilbert and Patco/Reinco. A motion was made by Mr. Carl to table these issues until Commissioner Leary can present further information. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

REQUEST FROM MANPOWER TEMPORARY SERVICES

A request from Manpower Temporary Services for the Board to reconsider \$1,000.00 fine. A motion was made by Mr. Carl to deny the request. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

REQUEST FROM WALKER FAIRLEY HALL

Meeting Called to Order

Chairman Strock called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m.

Approval of June 22, 1995 meeting minutes.

Mr. Cannon moved the minutes of June 22, 1995 be accepted as presented and unanimously carried.

Public Comment

There were no comments from the public.

Jo-Del, Inc. Notice of Appeal

Information presented to the Board as verification of the appeal of the judgment received by Mr. Jones against Jo-Del.

Proposed Rule Changes

At the May 23, 1995 meeting the Board reviewed changes to its rules proposed by the Division, and accepted those proposals, except the proposal which would specifically allow persons holding the general building classification to do residential work. The proposals were put out for public comment, of which only one, from the Home Builders Association, was received. That comment urged the Board to adopt a rule change which would allow general building contractors to perform residential work. Mr. Bell stated that most Board members are uncomfortable with the decision made in May regarding these classifications. A concern is that we have flip-flopped and we do not understand what we have voted for and voted for something we are not in agreement with. Mr. Strock stated that what the Board voted for was if you are a general contractor you can only do commercial work, if you are a residential contractor you can only do residential work. To upgrade these contractors whether tested or grandfathered they need to send in documentation to upgrade and the residential will be added. Mr. White asked how are we going to get the information out to all general contractors who were here. Mr. Carl says that they were told that if they hold a general building classification they can do it all, and in good faith the contractor took the general building test only. Mr. Carl stated that our main concern is what has been done in the past, all we are trying to do is making it a level playing field. How this situation is rectified is all that I am concerned with. Ms. Leary stated I don't believe it is a problem to rectify this problem. A directive to the officers and staff to say from this day forward it is very clear to the Board if you are a general contractor you have to take the general building test and if you are a residential contractor you have to take the residential test, if you do both you have to take both test. Mr. Cannon moved that the Home Builders comment be rejected and that those grandfathered licensees who were inadvertently misled in their classifications of work be granted by the department, those contractors who tested in the same situation and were misled be granted that same classification or additional classifications because of these extenuating circumstances. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

Quorum

Discussion with Board Members about having and maintaining a quorum for all meetings. Mr. Strock suggested that all Board Members search their souls regarding how they feel about continued participation with the Board. Also, possibly holding a meeting once every two months. It may be easier for all of us to commit at meeting six times per year instead of twelve.

Parsons & Sons General Contracting

Mr. Cannon moved to reinstate Parsons & Sons General Contracting (WV003951) contractors license because judgment has been paid. Motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

Workers' Compensation/Unemployment Compensation

The West Virginia Division of Labor is not renewing licenses to contractors who are delinquent with their Workers' Compensation funds. Mr. Jividen requested the board to state where they receive authority to not renew licensees who owe Workers' Compensation 21-11-2 to enforce uniform compliance with all the laws in the State of West Virginia to ensure a level playing field with all contractors.

Commissioner Leary's Comments

Voiced concerns about the testing procedures in reference to written and telephone complaints about testing and how much it cost to pass the test. Mr. Strock stated he didn't think it cost too much for the testing we just have too many people flunking. I think it would be a good idea to put on a seminar for testing that have the highest fail rate. If someone comes in and thinks they're an electrician and fails the test three times, I personally don't want them working on my house. I would also like to know who is taking these test and how many times they're taking the test. Find out how many people are being inconvenienced? Mr. Strock requested that the Board members be sent copies of the test that was given in their disciplines, so they can review the test.

3.12. "Electrical Contractor" means a person who engages in the business of contracting to install, erect, repair or alter electrical equipment for the generation, transmission or utilization of electrical energy and work incidental thereto.

3.13. An "emergency basis" under W. Va. Code §21-11-6(c)(6) exists upon occurrence of an event, circumstance or situation which presents an imminent threat to persons or property constituting a serious health or safety hazard.

3.14. "Employee of a contractor" means any individual who works under the control and supervision of a contractor subject to this Rule for a wage and other benefits as required by law. An employee of a contractor is not a subcontractor.

3.15. "Excavation (specialty) Contractor" means a contractor whose primary business is the installation, alteration, and repair of earthen material by digging, trenching, grading, or compacting the material for a cut, fill, grade, or trench and work incidental thereto, including the installation, alteration, and repair of crib walls, gabion walls, and other devices not to exceed six (6) feet in height for the purpose of controlling the movement of earthen materials.

3.16. "General Building Contractor" means a person whose principal business is in connection with any structures built, being built or to be built for the support, shelter and enclosure of persons, animals, chattels or movable property of any kind, requiring in the construction the use of more than two contractor classifications, or a person who supervises the whole or any part of the construction. A general building contractor is considered to be a commercial, business or industrial contractor. A general building contractor who desires to perform electrical; plumbing; heating, ventilating and cooling; piping; or general engineering contracting work as defined in this rule; shall obtain a license in those classifications.

3.17. "General Engineering Contractor" means a person whose principal business is in connection with public or private works projects, including, but not limited to, one or more of the following: Irrigation, drainage and water supply projects; electrical generation projects; swimming pools; flood control; harbors; railroads; highways; tunnels; airports and airways; sewers and sewage disposal systems; bridges; inland waterways; pipelines for transmission of petroleum and other liquid or gaseous substances; refineries; chemical plants and other industrial plants requiring a specialized engineering knowledge and skill; piers and foundations; and structures or work incidental thereto. "Swimming pools" means a public swimming pool as defined by the Building Officials and Code Administrators B.O.C.A. National Building Code/1990, Article 6, Section 623.2.A.

3.18. "Heating, Ventilating and Cooling Contractor" means a person who engages in the business of contracting to install, erect, repair, service or alter heating, ventilating and air conditioning equipment or systems to heat, cool or ventilate residential and commercial structures or work incidental thereto.

3.19. "Landscaping (specialty) Contractor" means a contractor whose primary business is preparation and alteration of land for horticulture and arboriculture and work incidental thereto, including irrigation systems and controls, the installation of non-loadbearing slabs, walkways, and areas using concrete, brick, stone, or gravel and all other materials and equipment associated with the installation of those materials. Excluded are concrete

slabs exceeding 400 square feet and concrete walkways exceeding 200 square feet in surface area. Excluded are retaining walls over three (3) feet in height, decorative walls or fences over six (6) feet in height, perimeter walls and fences, and load-bearing slabs and walkways. Carpentry is limited to decorative fences and screens, planter boxes, and plant tubs common to the industry.

3.20. "License" means a license to engage in business in this state as a contractor in one of the classifications set out in this rule.

3.21. "Low Voltage Systems (specialty) Contractor" means a contractor engaged in the installation, repair or maintenance of communication, monitoring, security, sound, and other systems utilizing low voltage electric currents, the system's directly related wiring, and work incidental thereto. "Low voltage" means wiring systems of 50 volts or less and the control circuits directly associated with the system. "Directly related wiring" means line voltage wiring not in excess of 300 volts originating at the load-side terminals of a disconnecting means or junction box that has been installed by persons properly licensed to install it for the sole purpose of supplying power to the low voltage system.

3.22. "Manufactured Home Installation (specialty) Contractor" means a contractor engaged in the installation of manufactured homes, as that term is defined by W. Va. Code § 21-9-1, including soil analysis, site preparation, construction of the foundation system, placement of the manufactured home, connection of the utilities, anchoring, ground moisture control, and finish carpentry. Possession of this license is in addition to possession of any license required pursuant to W. Va. Code § 21-9-1.

3.23. "Masonry (specialty) Contractor" means a contractor whose primary business is the installation of brick, concrete block, stone, marble, slate or other units and products common to the masonry industry, with or without mortar and work incidental thereto, including the installation of grout, caulking, tuck pointing, sand blasting, mortar washing, parging, cleaning, and welding of reinforcement steel related to masonry construction.

3.24. "Multifamily Contractor" means a person who is engaged in the construction, repair or improvement of a multifamily residential structure or work incidental thereto. "Multifamily residential structure" means a structure containing two or more residential units.

3.25. "Person" includes an individual, firm, sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, association or other entity engaged in the undertaking of construction projects, or any combination thereof.

3.26. "Piping Contractor" means a person whose principal business is the installation of process, power plant, air, oil, gasoline, chemical or other kinds of piping; and boilers and pressure vessels using joining methods of thread, weld, solvent weld or mechanical methods or work incidental thereto.

3.27. "Plumbing Contractor" means a person whose principal business is the installation, maintenance, extension and alteration of piping, plumbing fixtures, plumbing appliances and plumbing appurtenances, venting systems and public or private water supply systems within or adjacent to any building or structure; including the installation of gas piping, chilled water piping in connection with refrigeration processes and comfort cooling, hot water piping in connection with building heating, piping for stand pipes or work incidental thereto.

3.28. "Posting of the license" means placing a copy of the contractor's license on each job site where contracting work is being performed by each contractor working at the job site location where the general public and inspecting agents of the Board can easily read each contractor's name, license number, license classification and license expiration date.

ATTACHMENT C

LICENSURE TIME-FRAME

A license can be issued within two or three days if the individual passes the required examinations and meets all other licensure requirements such as: Secretary of State (Certificate of Authority) if they are applying as a corporation whether a foreign corporation or in-state. (The approximate time to receive a certificate of authority is around two (2) weeks.) If they have employees they must register with Workers' Compensation and Unemployment Compensation. A business tax registration can be applied for as a walk-in and a temporary number issued the same day. If commercial work is performed a wage bond must be posted if the entity has not performed work in the State for (5) five consecutive years.

The timely manner in which a contractor can become licensed depends a great deal on the contractor (licensee). The Board has licensed contractors on the same day after taking the required examinations and providing a completed application. Test scores can be obtained on the same day the test is taken.


