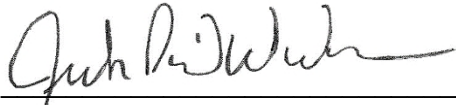
S.B. 827 – Providing definition for regional distribution and dismantling center of salvage yards
