A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Senator Weld, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

S. B. 590 - Creating Local Government Labor Regulatory Limitation Act.

Tom Smith, Chief Counsel, explained the bill, the purpose of the proposed committee substitute, and responded to questions.

The question being on agreeing to the committee substitute, the same was put, and the committee substitute was agreed to.

Senator Weld moved to report the committee substitute to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass.

The Chair being in doubt, a division of the body was demanded by Chairman Trump.

The vote being 12 in favor and 4 opposed, the bill will be reported.

S. B. 616 - Modifying definition of family subject to provisions of domestic violence laws.


J. A. Curia, Counsel, explained the bill, the purpose of the proposed committee substitute, and responded to questions.
