Minutes for August 07, 2023, 1:30 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on the Judiciary met on August 07, 2023, 1:30 PM in Room 208-W.

Members present: Senators Azinger, Caputo, Chapman, Deeds, Hamilton, Hunt, Maynard, Rucker, Stover, Stuart, Swope, Taylor, Weld, Woelfel, and Trump.

Members absent: Martin and Takubo.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

Senator Weld moved to approve the minutes.

On motion of Senator Rucker, the minutes were amended to reflect her attendance.

The minutes were approved as amended.

S. B. 1006 - Updating temporary identification cards for released inmates.

Carl Fletcher, Counsel, explained the bill and responded to questions.

With leave of the committee, Brad Douglas, Executive Office, West Virginia Department of Corrections, was administered the oath prescribed by Senate Rule 28a by Chairman Trump, addressed the committee, and responded to questions. (See attached oath.)

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee amended the bill on page 2, line 31, subsection (f), by striking the words "make efforts to".

On motion of Senator Chapman, the committee amended the bill on page 2, line 25, subsection (e), by striking the word "seven" and inserting in lieu thereof the number "30".

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee reported the bill to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass as amended.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee adopted the title amendment.

S. B. 1007 - Requiring municipalities to reimburse responsible county regional jail per diem fees in certain cases.

Carl Fletcher, Counsel, explained the bill and proposed strike and insert, and responded to questions.

Senator Weld moved to adopt the strike and insert amendment.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee adopted the strike and insert amendment.

On motion of Senator Hunt, the committee reported the bill to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass as amended.

S. B. 1008 - Clarifying conditions for pretrial release.

Carl Fletcher, Counsel, explained the bill, the proposed strike and insert and title amendment, and responded to questions.

Senator Weld moved to adopt the strike and insert amendment.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee adopted the strike and insert amendment.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee reported the bill to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass as amended.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee adopted the title amendment.
