[SB92](#) Presented by Kylie Webber Committee Counsel- Glucagon for Schools Act. No one from any association, agency, or the public spoke on the bill. SB92 was advanced to markup and discussion.

[SB154](#) Presented by Kylie Webber Committee Counsel - Prohibiting sexual orientation instruction in public schools. No agencies spoke on the bill. Association speakers included Jim Brown, Heather Hutchins with the WVEA, Joshua Gary VP of AFTWV. One Teacher from the public came to speak on the bill. SB154 will advance to markup and discussion.

[SB155](#) Presented by Kylie Webber Committee Counsel - Establishing Summer Feeding for All Program. No one from any association, agency, or the public spoke on the bill. SB 155 advanced to mark up and discussion.

[SB474](#) Presented by Aaron Kidd Committee Counsel- Ending diversity, equity, and inclusion programs. Katie Franklin spoke on the bill and answered questions from Delegates Hamilton, Pushkin, Hornby, Miller. One person from the public spoke on the bill. SB 474 was advanced to markup and discussion.

[SB581](#) Presented by Aaron Kidd Committee Counsel- Relating to school attendance and student participation in 4-H activities. No one from any association, agency, or the public spoke on the bill. SB 581 advanced to mark up and discussion.

[SB646](#) Presented by Aaron Kidd Committee Counsel - Increasing non-traditional instruction days for WV teachers. No one from any association, agency, or the public spoke on the bill. SB 646 advanced to mark up and discussion.

[SB765](#) Presented by Kylie Webber Committee Counsel - Establishing Troops-to-Teachers Program. No one from any association, agency, or the public spoke on the bill. SB 765 advanced to mark up and discussion.

[SB866](#) Presented by Melissa White Committee Counsel- Requiring WV Board of Education to promulgate legislative rule in consultation with WV Board of Physical Therapy. No one from any association, agency, or the public spoke on the bill. SB 866 advanced to mark up and discussion.
