Committee on Environment, Infrastructure, and Technology

Minutes for March 4, 2025, 4:00 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Committee on Environment, Infrastructure, and Technology met on March 4, 2025, 4:07pm, in the House Judiciary Committee Room 410M.

Members absent: Delegate Green.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Delegate Hillenbrand, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

The next order of business was to discuss bills categorized as Markup/Passage:

H. B. 2502, Establishing limitations on billing practices of Internet or telecommunications providers that fail to provide subscribed customers service for five or more days.

- Chairman Linville explained that after further discussions on the bill, that the committee will delay action until the next meeting in order to draft an amendment.

H. B. 2742, Relating to creating limited waiver from certificate of public convenience and necessity requirement for certain water or sewer services projects.

- Chairman Linville recognized counsel to explain the bill. Following the explanation, the Chairman called for questions from the committee. Hearing none, the Chairman looked to the Vice Chairman for a motion. Vice Chairman Hillenbrand made the motion that the bill be moved to the Standing Committee with the recommendation that it do pass. The motion was adopted.

With there being no further business to come before the committee, Chairman Linville recognized Vice-Chairman Hillenbrand for purposes of making a motion to adjourn.
