Standing Committee on Health and Human Resources

Minutes for March 24, 2025, 4:30 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Standing Committee on Health and Human Resources met on March 24, 2025, 4:30 PM, in the House East Wing Committee Room 215-E.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Delegate Hite, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Chair Worrell recognized Delegate Holstien explained HB 2133 - Clarifying that the time limitations provided for filing occupational pneumoconiosis claims do not apply or otherwise limit the ability of a claimant to obtain an evaluation from the Occupational Pneumoconiosis Board (2nd REF JUD). Delegate Holstien answered questions of the committee. Chair Worrell advanced HB 2133 to markup.

Chair Worrell recognized counsel to explain Com Sub for HB 3382 - Addressing the placement of foster children and creating a central reception center and emergency resource homes. (2nd REF FIN). Chair Worrell called for questions of counsel. Counsel answered questions. There being no amendments, Vice Chair moved Com Sub for HB 3382 be reported to the floor with the recommendation that it do pass, but first be referred to the Committee on Finance. Motion carried.

Chair Worrell recognized counsel to explain Com Sub for H B 2410 - Safeguard the Right-To-Try Cutting-Edge Medicine Act (2nd REF JUD). Chair Worrell called for questions of counsel. Counsel answered questions. There being no amendments, Vice Chair moved Com Sub for HB 2410 be reported to the floor with the recommendation that it do pass, but first be referred to the Committee on the Judiciary. Motion carried.

Chair Worrell recognized counsel to explain Com Sub for H B2730 - Relating to establishing a pilot program to develop a childcare program where the state, employer, and employee, contribute one-third of the total cost each (2nd REF FIN). Chair Worrell called for questions of counsel. Counsel answered questions. There being no amendments, Vice Chair moved Com Sub for HB 2730 be reported to the floor with the recommendation that it do pass, but first be referred to the Committee on Finance. Motion carried.
