Minutes for February 24, 2025, 2:00 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Subcommittee on Agriculture, Commerce, and Tourism met on February 24, 2025, 2:00 PM, in the House Government Organization Committee Room 215-E.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

Mark-up and Passage on HB2158, relating to removal of a sunset clause for the West Virginia spay and neuter program. Vice-Chair Sheedy moved the bill. Counsel explained that a committee substitute was being submitted. Vice-Chair Sheedy moved the committee substitute. Counsel explained the committee substitute. After discussion, the Chair moved the Committee Substitute for HB2158 be reported to the Standing Committee on Government Organization with the recommendation that it do pass. Mark-up and Passage on HB2030, modifying compulsory housing for hotels and motels. Vice-Chair Sheedy moved the bill. Counsel explained that a committee substitute was being submitted.
