## Committee on Environment, Infrastructure, and Technology

Minutes for March 18, 2025, 4:00 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Committee on Environment, Infrastructure, and Technology met on March 18, 2025, 4:00 PM, in the House Judiciary Committee Room 410-M.

On motion of Delegate Hillenbrand, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

The next order of business is bills on Markup and discussion.

**H. B. 2645**, Requiring certain non-discretionary procedures be strictly complied with by the West Virginia Parkways Authority before tolls, rents, fees or charges may be increased.

Counsel explained the bill. Questions and discussion followed. There were no amendments. Chairman Linville recognized the Vice-Chairman for a motion. Vice-Chairman moved that the bill be reported to the Standing Committee with the recommendation that it do pass. Chairman Linville put the question to the Members, there was no discussion, and the motion was adopted.

**H. B. 3179**, Funding for failing public utilities.

Counsel explained the bill. Questions and discussion followed. There were no amendments. Chairman Linville recognized the Vice-Chairman for a motion. Vice-Chairman moved that the bill be reported to the Standing Committee with the recommendation that it do pass. Chairman Linville put the question to the Members, there were comments from the Vice-Chair speaking in favor of the bill, and then the motion was adopted.

With there being no further business to come before the committee. The Chairman recognized the Vice-Chairman for a motion. The Vice-Chairman moved to adjourn. The Chairman put the question to the Members and the committee adjourned.
