The committee considered House Bill 5203 - To forbid any municipality from issuing an ID for the purposes of voting in a municipal election. Counsel explained the bill. On motion of Vice-Chairman Ward, House Bill 5203 was reported to the Standing Committee on the Judiciary.

The committee held a hearing on House Bill 5351 - Relating to modernization of fees generated from emergency communication service users. The Chair recognized the bill sponsor, Delegate Hornby, to explain the bill. After questions of the bill sponsor, the Chair advanced consideration of House Bill 5351 to Markup and Passage.
