## Standing Committee on the Judiciary

Minutes for January 21, 2026, 9:00 AM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Standing Committee on the Judiciary met on January 21, 2026, at 9:00 AM, in the House Judiciary Committee Room 410-M with Delegate Akers in the Chair.

Chairman Akers recognized the clerk for purposes of receiving subcommittee reports:

The House Subcommittee on Legal Services has had under consideration House Bill 4484 and reports the same back, with amendment, to the Standing Committee on the Judiciary.

### **House Bill 4169**, Relating to mental health examination requirements

Chairman Akers recognized counsel for purposes of explaining the bill. Chairman Akers called for amendments to the bill. On motion of Vice-Chairman Maynor, a committee substitute for the bill was offered.

Vice-Chairman Maynor moved to report Committee Substitute for House Bill 4169 to the floor with the recommendation that it do pass. Chairman Akers called for discussion on the motion. **House Bill 4364**, Relating to concurrent juvenile jurisdiction on military installations

**House Bill 4484**, To allow county commissions to have the same flexibility to sell or lease property as municipalities

Chairman Akers recognized Delegate Clark as the lead sponsor for purposes of explaining the bill. Chairman Akers called for questions for Delegate Clark regarding the bill. Questions from the committee members followed. Chairman Akers advanced the bill to markup and discussion.
