Minutes for January 19, 2026, 2:05 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Pensions met on January 19, 2026, 2:05 PM in Room 451-M.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

Chair Oliverio welcomed back committee members and staff. He apologized to those present, for having to attend meetings on a holiday, explaining the legislative session runs for 60 days straight.

Chair Oliverio recognized Jeffrey Fleck, Executive Director of the Consolidated Public Retirement Board, (CPRB), emphasizing that Mr. Fleck has been sworn in on numerous occasions. Mr. Fleck then introduced his support staff to the committee. Those individuals being, Terasa Miller -Deputy Director and Chief Operating Officer; Jeaneen Legato -Board Counsel; Kenneth Woodson - Board Actuary; and Calvin Long - Actuary Analyst.

Mr. Fleck provided the committee with a handout detailing the history of and current level of commitment and funding for the ten retirement accounts which they oversee. Chair Oliverio asked him about any recommendation he may be bringing to the committee. Mr. Fleck indicated that there would be proposed "Clean up" legislation, once it is board approved.
