Minutes for January 27, 2026, 12:34 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure met on January 27, 2026, 12:34 PM in Room 451.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Senator Taylor, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Chair Maynard welcomed back all returning members of the committee and new Senator Zack Maynard to the committee. He then introduced the committee staff, his administrative assistant and the Intern assigned to the committee.
