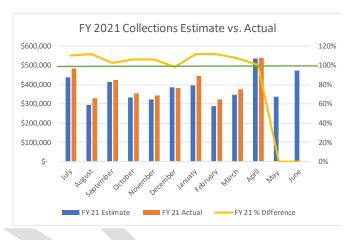

General Revenue

General Revenue collections for April totaled \$539,765,136, exceeding the monthly estimate of \$537,879,000 by \$1,886,136 Total year to date General Revenue collections are \$4,001,272,969.

As of the end of April the state has collected 87% of its total estimated yearly revenue of \$4,574,514,000. At this time, the state should have collected 82% of its yearly revenue. This current trend puts the state **on track** for meeting yearly revenue estimates.

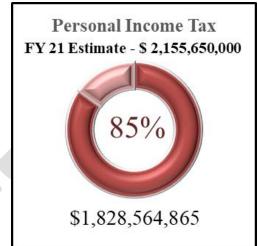
Personal Income Tax

Personal income tax (PIT) collections for the month were \$241,006,846. This figure is \$81,193,154 **below** the April estimate of \$322,200,000*. The total year to date personal income tax collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$1,828,564,865.

Fiscal Year 2021 PIT YTD Performance Exceeding estimates by \$17,114,865



As of the end of April the state has collected 85% of its total estimated PIT yearly collections of \$2,155,650,000. At this time the state should have collected 84% of its PIT yearly collections. This current trend puts the state **on track** for meeting the PIT yearly collections estimate. **The deadline for filing a 2020 individual tax return was pushed back to May 17, 2021.*

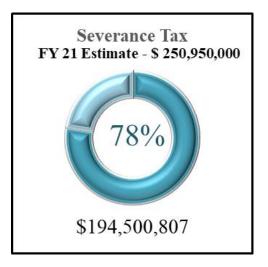
Severance Tax

Severance tax collections for April were \$29,062,858. This figure is \$14,162,858 **above** the monthly estimate of \$14,900,000. Total severance tax collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$194,500,807.

Fiscal Year 2021 Severance Tax YTD Performance Exceeding estimates by **\$19,400,807**



As of the end of April the state has collected 78% of its total yearly collections of 250,950,000. At this time the state should have collected 70% * of its yearly severance tax collections. This current trend puts the state **on track** for meeting the yearly severance tax collection estimate.

*Severance Tax estimated collections for the first 6 months of the yearly were \$78,000,000, and for the last six months of the year are estimated at \$172,950,000.

Other Notable Collections

Consumer Sales and Service Tax collections for the month were \$22,285,630 **above** the April estimate of \$103,800,000 at \$126,085,630.

Tobacco Products Tax collections for April were \$16,069,762. These collections were **above** the monthly estimate of \$12,300,000 by \$3,769,762.

Lottery

Total gross lottery collections for March were \$118,356,000. This figure is \$28,437,000 **above** the monthly estimate of \$89,919,000. Total gross lottery collections for fiscal year 2021 are \$845,215,000.

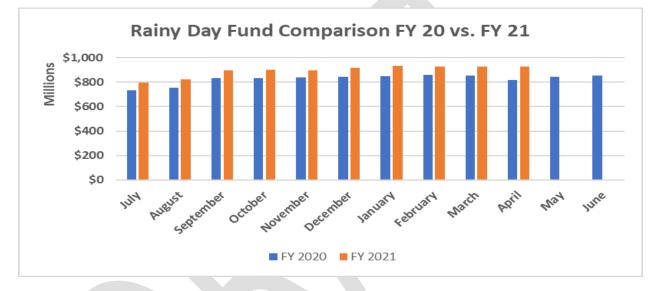
