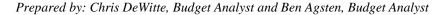

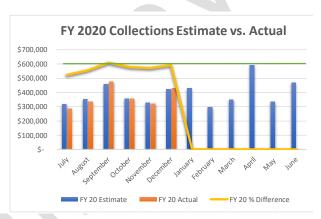

General Revenue

General Revenue collections for December totaled \$428,235,606, **exceeding** the monthly estimate of \$421,352,000 by \$6,883,606. Bringing the total year to date General Revenue collections to \$2,203,543,487.

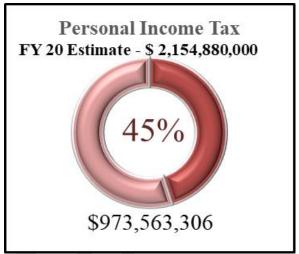
Personal Income Tax

Personal income tax (PIT) collections for the month were \$174,772,440. This figure is \$3,207,560 **below** the December estimate of \$177,980,000. The total year to date personal income tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$973,563,306.

As of the end of December the state has collected 45% of its total estimated PIT yearly collections of \$2,154,880,000. At this time the state should have collected 47% of its PIT yearly collections. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting the PIT yearly collections estimate.

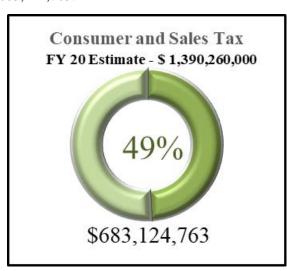
Consumer Sales and Service Tax

Collections of the Consumer Sales and Service Tax (CS&S) for the month of December were \$127,346,724 and were \$1,153,276 **below** the monthly estimate of \$128,500,000. Total Consumer Sales and Service Tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$683,124,763.

As of the month of December the state has collected 49.14% of its yearly estimated collections. At this time the state should have collected 49.34% of its yearly estimate. This current trend puts the state **not on** track for meeting the yearly CS&S tax collection estimate.

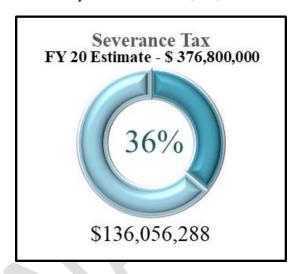
Severance Tax

Severance tax collections for December were \$42,949,755. This figure is \$149,755 **above** the monthly estimate of \$42,800,000. Total severance tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$136,056,288.

As of the end of December the state has collected 36% of its total yearly collections of \$376,800,000. At this time the state should have collected 46% of its yearly severance tax collections. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting the yearly severance tax collection estimate.

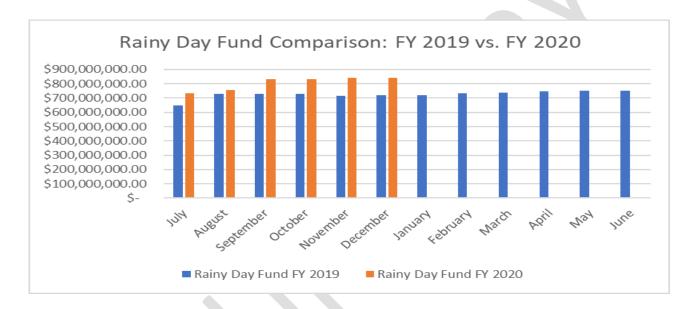
