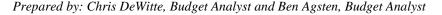

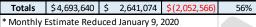


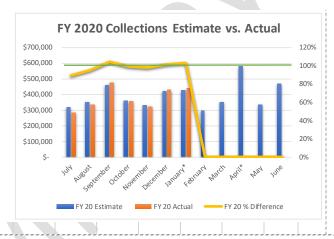

General Revenue

General Revenue collections for January totaled \$437,531,017, **exceeding** the monthly estimate of \$424,541,000 by \$12,990,017. Bringing the total year to date General Revenue collections to \$2,641,074,504.

As of the end of January the state has collected 56% of its total estimated yearly revenue of \$4,710,200,000. At this time, the state should have collected 57% of its yearly revenue. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting yearly revenue estimates.

Notes on General Revenue Collections

On January 9, 2020 the Governor lowered yearly revenue estimates by \$16,560,000. He lowered the January estimate by \$6,000,000 and the April estimate by \$10,560,000.

On January 13, 2020 the State Treasurer transferred a total of \$20,000,000 to the state's general revenue fund: \$10,000,000 from the States Unclaimed Property Fund; and \$10,000,000 from the Treasurer's Banking Services account. This transfer increased January collections by \$20,000,000.

The unadjusted revenue collections for January would be \$417,531,017 which is \$13,010,000 **below** the original estimate of \$430,541,000.

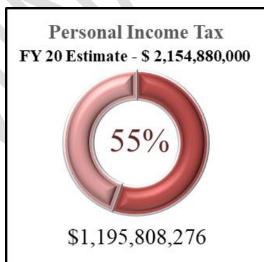
Personal Income Tax

Personal income tax (PIT) collections for the month were \$222,244,970. This figure is \$1,955,030 **below** the January estimate of \$224,200,000. The total year to date personal income tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$1,195,808,276.

As of the end of January the state has collected 55% of its total estimated PIT yearly collections of \$2,154,880,000. At this time the state should have collected 57% of its PIT yearly collections. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting the PIT yearly collections estimate.

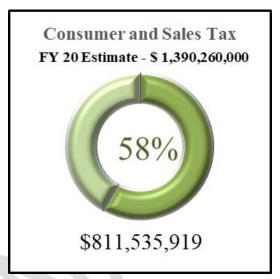
Consumer Sales and Service Tax

Collections of the Consumer Sales and Service Tax (CS&S) for the month of January were \$128,411,156 and were \$1,211,156 **above** the monthly estimate of \$127,200,000. Total Consumer Sales and Service Tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$811,535,919.

As of the month of January the state has collected 58.37% of its yearly estimated collections. At this time the state should have collected 58.49% of its yearly estimate. This current trend puts the state **not on** track for meeting the yearly CS&S tax collection estimate.

Severance Tax

Severance tax collections for January were \$20,365,348. This figure is \$834,652 **below** the monthly estimate of \$21,200,000. Total severance tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$156,421,636.

As of the end of January the state has collected 43% of its total yearly collections of \$360,240,000. At this time the state should have collected 53% of its yearly severance tax collections. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting the yearly severance tax collection estimate.

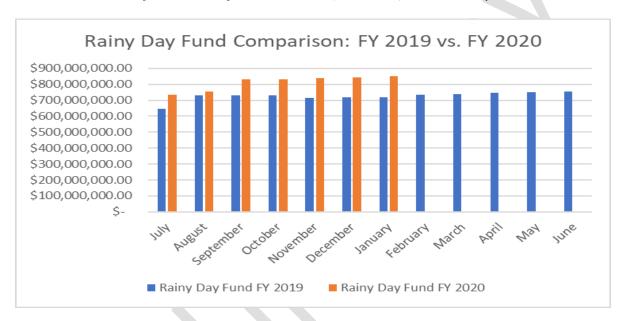
