SUBJECT: Per Diem and Reimbursement Information

The following is information about the current per diem and the allowable reimbursements.

Per Diem:

By Administrative Order, the Court established \$435 as the daily per diem for Senior Status Judges.

Limitations: "[P]er diem and retirement compensation of a senior judge shall not exceed the salary of a sitting judge..." W. V. Code 51-9-10 (1991). Judges Retirement System.

W.V. Public Employees Retirement Act, W. V. Code 5-10-48 (2011) states: "A retirant may accept temporary full-time or temporary part-time employment. . . so long as he or she does not receive annual compensation in excess of \$15,000."

Expense Reimbursement:

Mileage: The current reimbursement rate is .555/miles. I shall send you a notice when this changes.

Daily living Expenses: An over-night stay is required to be reimbursed for any meals and reimbursement is based on U. S. General Services Administration allowances. Currently, in Charleston and Shepherdstown, the daily rate is \$51 with the first and last days at \$38.50. Currently, in the rest of West Virginia, including Morgantown and Wheeling, the daily rate is \$46 with the first and last days at \$34.50. I shall send you a notice when this changes.
