Executive Summary Dangerous Student's Report

W.Va. State Code §18A-5-1a: Possessing deadly weapons on premises of educational facilities; possessing a controlled substance on premises of educational facilities; assaults and batteries committed by pupils upon teachers or other school personnel; temporary suspension, hearing; procedure, notice and formal hearing; extended suspension; sale of narcotic; expulsion; exception; alternative education.

W.Va. State Code §18A-5-1a defines a dangerous student as one who is substantially likely to cause serious bodily injury to himself, herself or another individual within that student's educational environment, which may include any alternative education environment, as evidenced by a pattern of series violent behavior exhibited by the student, and documented in writing, by the school, with the documentation provided to the student and parent or guardian at the time of the offense. W.Va. State Code §18-5-1a also states that if a county board of education expels a student and finds that the student is a "dangerous student", they may refuse to provide alternative education. County boards are directed to report the number of pupils determined to be dangerous students to the West Virginia Board of Education (WVBOE). The state board is required to compile the county boards' statistics and shall report its findings to the Legislative Oversight Commission on Education Accountability (LOCEA).

During the 2012-13 school year, there were no reported incidents of students expelled from any county under the "dangerous student" category. However, in order for the WVBOE and LOCEA to monitor the pulse of student discipline, the following report provides in aggregate the number of level 4 inappropriate behaviors (Safe Schools Act Behaviors that are consistent with those addressed in *W.Va. State Code §18A-5-1a*) reported by schools into the West Virginia Educational Information System.

This preliminary data is part of a more detailed report on student behaviors that will be provided to the West Virginia State Board of Education (WVBOE) in November of 2013. The West Virginia Board of Education was one of three states awarded funding from the National Association of State Boards of Education to examine and reform state disciplinary policies. This report will allow the WVBOE to analyze state-wide school discipline behaviors and then use the data to establish goals to improve school discipline practices in West Virginia. As part of this project, the WVBOE will also create reports that will be sent to each of the 55 school districts that will include discipline data for each school in the district, county discipline data in comparison with state discipline data. It will be the expectation of the WVBOE that school districts will use this data, as well as other local data to make data driven decisions regarding improving discipline improvement practices. The West Virginia Department of Education's Office of Research will conduct focus groups/planning events with regional and local education stakeholders to facilitate the use of the data. Also, the project calls for the WVBOE to publicly showcase those schools who demonstrate successes in reducing inappropriate behavior.
