Dear Governor Tomblin:

Enclosed is a compilation of receipts and expenditures from the Oil and Gas Reclamation Fund for fiscal year 2011, as required by WV Code 22-6-29(b). During the fiscal year, \$234,500 was collected and deposited in the fund of which \$50,000 was from bond forfeitures, and \$184,500 was from permit fees. Expenditures from the fund were \$153,057 and were for the purpose of plugging or reclaiming abandoned wells. Over the course of the fiscal year, three wells were plugged, one site had repairs made to it, and an oil spill was cleaned up.
