Enclosed is a compilation of receipts and expenditures from the Oil and Gas Reclamation Fund for Fiscal Year 2012, as required by WV Code 22-6-29(b). During the fiscal year, \$130,676 was collected and deposited in the fund from permit fees and other revenues. Expenditures from the fund were \$220,457 and were for the purpose of plugging or reclaiming abandoned wells. Over the course of the fiscal year, one well was plugged.
