President Kessler and Speaker Miley:

Enclosed is a compilation of receipts and expenditures from the Landfill Closure Assistance Program Fund (LCAP) for fiscal year 2014, as required by WV Code 22-16-12(h). During the fiscal year, \$8,806,918 was deposited into the fund and \$4,148,398 was expended.

The LCAP was established to provide landfill closure assistance to owners/permittees of landfills that were required to cease operations pursuant to certain statutory closure deadlines for non-composite lined facilities. As funds are available, the program designs and constructs all closure related activities to provide sufficient leachate management, sediment and erosion control, gas management, groundwater monitoring, and a final cover cop on non-composite lined landfills. The program began with 28 landfills. Four landfills have been added to the original inventory by the Legislative process, including two in the 2014 Legislative session. There are 7 landfills left to be closed.
