Enclosed is a compilation of receipts and expenditures from the Oil and Gas Reclamation Fund for Fiscal Year 2014, as required by WV Code 22-6-29(b).

During the fiscal year, \$141,250 was collected and deposited in the fund from permit fees and other revenues. Expenditures from the fund were \$126,570 which were for the purpose of plugging or reclaiming abandoned wells. Over the course of the fiscal year, two wells were plugged, and two oil spill sites were remediated.
