Attached is a compilation of receipts and expenditures from the Oil and Gas Operating Permit and Processing Fund for Fiscal Year 2019, as required pursuant to WV Code Chapter 22, Article 22-6-29(b).

During the fiscal year 2019, **\$84,450** were collected and deposited into the fund from permit fees and other revenues. Expenditures from the fund were \$91,064 which covered plugging of the SS Davis #1 Well in Pleasants County and a spill cleanup and tank removal on the Chambers #1 Well in Roane County.
