Executive Summary

The purpose of this report is to provide a high-level overview of the State of West Virginia's outstanding debt as of June 30, 2024. Per West Virginia Code, the West Virginia State Treasurer's Office (WVSTO) prepares quarterly debt update reports. The March and September reports are shorter in length, three-month updates. The June and December reports are more detailed, covering six months of the fiscal year. In addition, the WVSTO compiles an Annual Debt Report as of June, summarizing the entire fiscal year.

This report is the fourth for fiscal year 2024. Tax supported debt as of June 30, 2024, decreased \$101.1 million from the December 31, 2023, balance. Non tax-supported debt increased \$403.8 million during the same time period.

This report also seeks to provide additional information on subjects related to check fraud. Even in 2024 with the ever-increasing rise of digital payment options, checks remain a widely used method of payment among both consumers and businesses.

While overall check volume has been declining in recent years, check fraud is booming as checks are easily susceptible to fraud.

Financial Loss from Check Fraud

In 2023, financial institutions reported unprecedented financial loss due to soaring check fraud. The recently published 2024 AFP Payments Fraud and Control Survey Report found that checks continue to be the most problematic payment method, with 65-percent of organizations reporting check fraud activity. Additionally, the report noted that, "Check fraud related to mail theft has become a significant issue for organizations and, more importantly, for the banking industry as they are easy targets for check fraud via mail." A few root causes of current surges in check fraud include mail theft from mailboxes and mail trucks, images of checks being sold on the dark web being manipulated and misdirected with imaging tools, and fake check ATM deposits.

Processing a Forgery or Fraudulent Check Claim

If a customer of your state agency or spending unit suspects a payment issued to them was fraudulently cashed due to forgery or a fraudulently created image of the original payment, they should be directed to the West Virginia Treasury's website to obtain the Forgery/Fraudulent Claim Form.

The payee of the original check should complete and notarize the form and return it to the West Virginia Treasury for processing with the current Banking Services vendor, Truist. This process typically takes four to eight weeks but can sometimes take much longer. The statute of limitations to request a forgery or fraudulent check claim is three years. During the investigation time, the state agency or spending unit should be working with the payee to sign up for electronic funds transfer (EFT) as their payment method going forward.

After the investigation, a determination will be made of whether the check was cashed fraudulently. If the forgery or fraudulent claim is honored, Truist will credit the West Virginia Treasury's bank account. The West Virginia Treasury Cash Accounting staff will enter a Cash Receipt (CR) document in wvOASIS for the deposit and will contact the state agency or spending unit to let them know the claim was honored. The West Virginia Treasury will also confirm with the state agency or spending unit if the vendor has been set up for EFT payments. If so, the funds will be deposited on the Cash Receipt (CR) document directly into the state agency or spending unit fund for a new payment to be issued. If EFT has not been established, the West Virginia Treasury will issue a new payment via a paper check.

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The West Virginia Treasury is always looking for ways to increase efficiencies as stewards of the state's monies. We have recently implemented new fraud-monitoring systems to increase our methods in eliminating check fraud schemes and reduce the number of fraudulent check claims.

What can agencies or spending units do? One of the best methods available to eliminate fraudulent checks being cashed is using EFT as a payment method. For information on how to register a vendor for EFT, please go to <u>Electronic Payments - wvsao.gov</u> and request the vendor complete the eVendor Agreement (Setup) form.

Executive Summary as of June 30, 2024

The State of West Virginia ended fiscal year 2024 with a net tax supported debt of \$2.55 billion, a decrease of 3.81% from December 31, 2023.

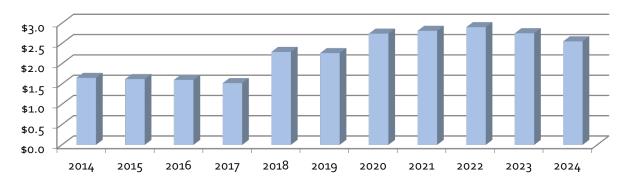
Net Tax Supported Debt Outstanding at June 30

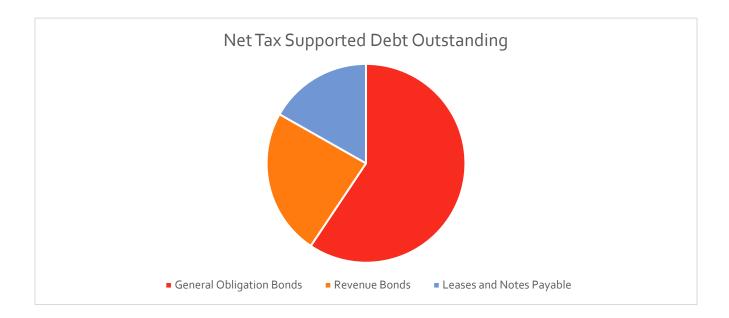

The amount of net tax supported debt in this report does not include claims and judgments, accrued compensated absences, pension costs, other post-employment benefit costs or other liabilities of the state. Those obligations are detailed in the state's Annual Comprehensive Financial Report, which is available from the Division of Finance of the Department of Administration or online at <u>ACFR (wv.gov)</u>.

The net tax supported debt calculation in this report includes General Obligation (GO) bonds, Lottery Revenue bonds, Excess Lottery Revenue bonds as well as lease and notes payable obligations of various state spending units.



GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS

Approximately \$1.52 billion of the State of West Virginia's \$2.55 billion in outstanding net tax supported debt as of June 30, 2024, consisted of GO bonds. Over the years, the State of West Virginia has issued GO bonds for road construction, school construction, veterans' bonuses and infrastructure development. All these bonds carry a pledge of the state to levy taxes if funds are insufficient to meet debt service. Outstanding GO bonds include roads bonds and infrastructure improvement bonds.

ROADS TO PROSPERITY BONDS

The Roads to Prosperity Amendment of 2017 authorized bonds in the aggregate amount of \$1.6 billion were issued over a four-year period.

Proceeds are to be used to match federal funds for highway and bridge construction as well as for general highway, secondary road and bridge construction and improvements in each of the state's 55 counties.

The initial \$800 million issuance occurred on June 7, 2018 and an additional \$600 million issuance occurred on December 17, 2019. The last and final issuance of \$214 million occurred on June 3, 2021. Debt service on the 2018 issue is approximately \$55.4 million for FY 2025 through the final maturity in 2043. Debt service on the 2019 issue is \$45.3 million for FY 2025 through the final maturity in June 2044. Debt service on the 2021 issue is approximately \$14.9 million for FY 2025 through the final maturity in June 2046.

As of June 30, 2024, the GO Road bonds will mature as follows:

1 - 5 years: 18%

6 - 10 years: 22%

11-15 years: 27%

16-20 years: 31%

21-25 years: 2%

SAFE ROAD BONDS

The Safe Roads Amendment of 1996 has 22.1 million outstanding as of June 30, 2024. All Safe Road Bonds authorized have been issued, and there are currently no remaining authorizations for the issuance of the Safe Road Bonds. The debt service is approximately \$23.2 million for fiscal year 2025.

INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT BONDS

The principal outstanding at June 30, 2024 for the Infrastructure Improvement Amendment bonds is \$42.8 million. The Division of Debt Management reports these bonds on a cash basis; however, one series of bonds was issued as Capital Appreciation Bonds (CABs). All the bonds are repaid from a dedication of the required debt service amount of coal

As of June 30, 2024, the GO Infrastructure Improvement bonds will mature as follows:

1 - 5 years: 100%

severance taxes and the taxing pledge of the state to meet any deficiencies. All GO infrastructure bonds authorized by the Infrastructure Improvement Amendment have been issued; therefore, there are currently no remaining authorizations for the issuance of GO infrastructure bonds; however, refunding bonds may be issued.

The combined debt service on the GO infrastructure bonds for fiscal year 2025 is approximately \$22.2 million, where it remains until all bonds mature in November 2026. All figures are as of June 30, 2024.

LEASES and NOTES PAYABLE

The State of West Virginia depends on lease and notes payable obligations to finance capital improvements, large purchases of computer equipment, vehicles and many other projects. There are approximately \$428.6 million in lease obligations outstanding as of June 30, 2024. Additional detail about the lease obligations is contained in *Appendix B – Debt by Spending Unit Fiscal Year 2024*, page 21.

Section 2 West Virginia Non Tax Supported Debt June 30, 2024

The State of West Virginia has more than 20 bonding authorities able to issue revenue bonds backed by various pledges. Each authority has its own specific parameters, including volume caps and interest rate caps, specified in West Virginia Code. For purposes of this report, this debt is considered "non tax supported debt."

The State of West Virginia has a non tax supported debt of approximately \$11.4 billion outstanding as of June 30, 2024. Additional detail about the bond issues is contained in *Appendix B – Debt by Spending Unit Fiscal Year* 2024, page 21.

Section 3 West Virginia Debt Issued January 1, 2024 - June 30, 2024

Approximately \$511 million in revenue bonds has been issued during the last half of fiscal year 2024. This includes a draw on a previously authorized issue of the West Virginia Economic Development Authority – Proctor & Gamble Series 2022A for \$77 million, a draw on a previously authorized issue of the West Virginia Economic Development Authority – Nucor 2022A for \$278 million, and a draw on a previously authorized issue of the West Virginia School Building Authority for \$686 thousand. Two issues of "new money" were made in the last half of fiscal year 2024 as follows: \$75 million issued by the West Virginia Housing Development Fund and \$80 million issued by the West Virginia Housing Development Fund.

The West Virginia Housing Development Fund Bonds

The West Virginia Housing Development Fund issued revenue bonds in the amount of \$75,000,000 for single family housing. The bonds were dated March 28, 2024, the True Interest Cost (TIC) was 3.99%. The bond ratings and cost of issuance were not provided to the WVSTO.

The West Virginia Housing Development Fund Bonds

The West Virginia Housing Development Fund issued revenue bonds in the amount of \$80,000,000 for single family housing. The bonds were dated June 18, 2024, the True Interest Cost (TIC) was 4.88%. The bond ratings and cost of issuance were not provided to the WVSTO.

West Virginia School Building Authority Revenue Bonds

The West Virginia Economic Development Authority issued revenue bonds on and existing bond in the amount of \$685,500 for school projects. The date of issuance, the True Interest Cost (TIC), bond ratings and cost of issuance were not provided to the WVSTO.

West Virginia Economic Development Authority Revenue Bonds for Proctor & Gamble Manufacturing Company

The West Virginia Economic Development Authority issued revenue bonds on and existing bond in the amount of \$77,025,557 for Proctor & Gamble Manufacturing, Series 2022. The date of issuance, the True Interest Cost (TIC), bond ratings and cost of issuance were not provided to the WVSTO.

West Virginia Economic Development Authority Revenue Bonds for Nucor in Mason County

The West Virginia Economic Development Authority issued revenue bonds on and existing bond in the amount of \$278,258,946 for Nucor in Mason County, Series 2022. The date of issuance, the True Interest Cost (TIC), bond ratings and cost of issuance were not provided to the WVSTO.

Section 4 Continuing Disclosure

WV Code 12-6A-5 (7) states the WVSTO should "monitor continuing disclosure requirements and post-issuance compliance issues with federal and state tax and securities law, including, without limitation, arbitrage, rebate and remedial measures."

The spending units listed in this report are responsible for reporting certain disclosures related to bond issuances on the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (MSRB) website, commonly called EMMA. Further, spending units are required to submit audited financial statements to EMMA in a timely manner, if the spending unit is audited. Section 5 Cash Flow Projections for Revenue Bonds

WV Code 12-6A-5 (2) states the WVSTO should "evaluate cash flow projections relative to proposed and existing revenue bond issues."

The State of West Virginia has several outstanding revenue bonds as listed in Appendix A on page 17. Revenue streams for the bonds come from the following sources according to the reporting spending units: court fees, tuition, room and board, the West Virginia Lottery, repayment of loans, local bondholders, interest, capital fees, rentals, appropriations, tolls, other auxiliary revenue, student fees, and pledges. Each spending unit reported sufficient revenue streams to cover the existing outstanding debt.

The WVSTO monitors revenue streams as it relates to outstanding bonds.
